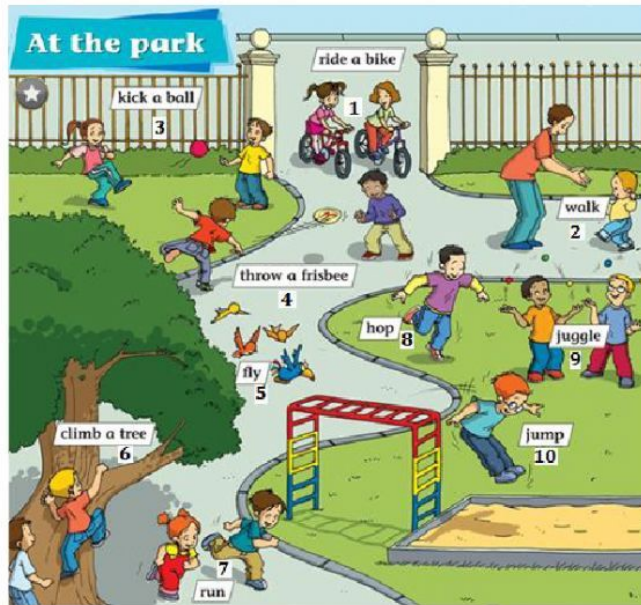


# Present Simple versus Present Continuous
